

TIMETABLE

Each tournament (Open and Under 150) will be a 6 round Swiss in which every player plays in all rounds. Players may take a ½-point bye in any round except the last one if requested on the entry form.

PRIZES

Open: 1st £150 2nd £75 **Grading £50 (209-180, under 180)**

Under 150: 1st £150 2nd £75 **Grading £50 (129-110, under 110)**

The ECF Grading List published in January 2015 or, if a new/corrected list is published before May 2015 then that list, will be used for grading purposes. Rapidplay grades take precedence over Standardplay ones.

Batsford has kindly donated book prizes for the best individual results by **Juniors** aged 14-15, 12-13, 10-11, and under 10 in each tournament..

A competitor may win more than one prize. In the event of a tie the main cash prizes will be shared and grading and Junior prizes will be decided by the sum of progressive scores, failing which these prizes will also be shared.

ENTRY FEES

£20.00 Adults, £15.00 Juniors (i.e. competitors born after 15 May 1999)

This is a registered ECF Game Fee event. Players who are not current ECF Members at Silver, Gold or Platinum level on the date of the congress must add £6 (£4 for Juniors) to their entry fee.

Entry fees will be refunded only to players who notify the organisers of their withdrawal by Wednesday 13 May 2015.

Entries on the day of the tournament will be subject to an additional entry fee of £5. In the first round entries on the day of the tournament will be paired at the organisers' discretion and may have less than 30 minutes each on the clock.

DEFAULTS

Anyone arriving more than 20 minutes late for the first round, or 10 minutes late for any other round will be defaulted. Players with absent opponents will then be re-paired as far as possible with the remaining time divided equally.

RULES

A player must make all moves within the 30 minutes on the clock. Detailed rules will be available at the tournament. The FIDE laws of chess (July 2014) apply except for article 11.3b which is replaced by the following: "Mobile phones and any other electronic means of communication must be switched off during games. If a mobile phone rings during play then the player involved will lose the game."

SMOKING

Smoking is NOT allowed in the venue.

REFRESHMENTS

Refreshments will be available from Café Trout at the front of the playing hall.

ECF GAME FEE

This is a registered ECF Game Fee event and all games will be included in the ECF Rapidplay grading list. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their grading information being published on the ECF Website.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Please contact Colin Mackenzie (see Entry Form) in advance if you have any special requirements (e.g. access) during the tournament.
